

CONTRACT FOR PROVISION OF EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

Together referred to as the "Parties", have entered into this Agreement as follows:

1. SUBJECT OF THE AGREEMENT

1.1. The Provider undertakes to provide the Customer (or the Student designated by the Customer) with services for conducting an individual course to overcome stuttering, "Freedom of Speech" (hereinafter – the "Course"), and the Customer undertakes to pay for these services in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement.

1.2. The Student is: [Full name of Student, date of birth]. The Customer confirms that he/she is acting in the interest of the Student and undertakes to ensure the Student's compliance with the terms of this Agreement.

1.3. The Course is conducted individually in an online format and includes:

- Diagnosis of the degree of stuttering to understand the estimated scope of work required for its elimination.
- Professional consultation on solving the stuttering problem with step-by-step consolidation of all necessary tools of the training program.
- Detailed explanation of situations that previously triggered speech blocks and finding specific solutions to replace them with normal speech (without stuttering).
- Conducting sessions and transferring information on overcoming stuttering until the learning material is fully absorbed.
- Explanation of the nature of speech blocks using clear and easily understandable examples.

- Analysis of all non-rational movements (NRMs) that lead to blocks and tensions unrelated to normal speech, and that may appear in the Student during the stage of consolidating a new habit of speaking freely and easily (on average within 21 days).
- Timely pointing out of all the Student's mistakes, explaining their origin, and conducting practical work to correct them and prevent them in the future.
- Multiple repetitions of key points necessary for subconscious consolidation to form light and effortless speech.
- Conducting a set of measures aimed at constant testing of speech, identifying and analyzing mistakes not only during individual sessions but also when the Student communicates in society (with family, friends, at school, at work, on the street, and in other situations).
- Consultation support not only during the sessions but also during the stage of consolidating the normal habit of speaking freely and naturally, without stuttering, from 8:00 AM to 11:00 PM Moscow time, as feasible via text messages, voice messages, phone calls, or Skype communication.
- Timely provision of all necessary exercises for consolidating a new, comfortable speech habit, with detailed instructions for use and expected results.
- Training the Student to use his/her speech apparatus like all normal (non-stuttering) people, with multiple checks for quality assimilation of the new useful skill in practice.
- Conducting a speech exam that will serve as a clear example of positive dynamics in overcoming stuttering.
- 10 individual sessions of 60 minutes each.
- Personal guidance and support between sessions in the Telegram messenger for 3 (three) months from the start date of the Course.
- Access to a private chat for course participants on Telegram.
- Access to the training chatbot on Telegram: https://t.me/methodproriv_bot, containing over 100 training videos with theory and practice, text documents, and summaries of the "BREAKTHROUGH" method.
- Lifetime access to the updated library of materials (chatbot) of the method.
- Provision of educational materials and methodological guides.
- Homework after each session with the possibility of receiving feedback from the Provider on days not designated for sessions.

1.4. Structure and frequency of personal sessions:

- Sessions 1-4 are held twice a week.
- Sessions 5-8 are held once a week.
- Sessions 9-10 are held once every 2 weeks.

Specific dates and times of sessions are agreed upon by the Parties as the Course progresses. The date and time of sessions may be rescheduled by mutual agreement of the Parties. For convenient scheduling, it is advisable to notify of a reschedule in advance (24 hours), however, notification on the day of the session is permitted by mutual agreement.

1.5. The Customer and Student acknowledge that, despite the provision of access to an extensive knowledge base (chatbot), attending personal sessions is necessary to achieve maximum results, during which the Provider creates and adjusts an individual plan based on the Student's progress dynamics in freeing speech and thoughts from stuttering. The Student has the opportunity to study independently every day, studying materials in the chatbot, and share feedback with the Provider to increase the effectiveness of the Course.

2. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES

2.1. The Provider undertakes to:

- Provide the services in full, with quality, and within the agreed timelines.
- Ensure qualified conduct of sessions in accordance with the stated methodology.
- Respect the Student's personality, maintain confidentiality regarding information obtained during the provision of services.
- Provide the Customer with access to the chat, chatbot, and all necessary materials for completing the Course.
- Provide support and feedback on homework.

2.2. The Customer undertakes to:

- Pay for the Provider's services in a timely manner and in full.
- Ensure the Student's timely attendance at sessions at the agreed time.
- In case of a need to reschedule a session, notify the Provider in advance. Notification 24 hours in advance is advisable, but notification on the day of the session is permitted by agreement with the Provider.
- Provide accurate information necessary for the provision of services.

2.3. The Customer has the right to:

- Demand that the Provider provide the services specified in this Agreement.
- Reschedule agreed sessions by notifying the Provider. The recommended notice period is 24 hours; in exceptional cases, rescheduling is possible with notification on the day of the session by agreement with the Provider.

3. COST OF SERVICES AND PAYMENT PROCEDURE

3.1. The full cost of the Course, including 3 (three) months of personal guidance and lifetime access to the method materials, is 1000 \$.

3.2. Payment shall be made by the Customer using one of the following methods at the Customer's choice:

- **Full prepayment:** Payment of 100% of the Course cost (1000\$) before the start of the first session. In this case, the Customer receives full access to all method materials (chatbot) immediately after payment, which contributes to faster achievement of results.
- **Installment payment:** Payment for the first 5 sessions separately, at a cost of 100\$ per session. After using 5 sessions, the Customer pays the difference up to the full cost of the Course in the amount of 500\$ to gain full access to the Course and continue sessions.
- **Installment plan (credit):** Arranging an installment plan through T-Bank and partners on the following terms: no down payment and no overpayment, first payment 30 days after loan approval, installment term – 6 or 12 months.

3.3. Payment is made by transferring funds to the Provider's bank account specified in this Agreement, or by any other mutually agreed method.

4. TERM OF THE AGREEMENT

4.1. This Agreement enters into force on the date of its signing by the Parties and remains in force until the Parties have fully performed their obligations.

5. LIABILITY OF THE PARTIES

5.1. For non-performance or improper performance of obligations under this Agreement, the Parties shall be liable in accordance with the current legislation of the Russian Federation.

5.2. The Provider does not give direct guarantees and is not directly liable for any specific result of each Student, as the final result depends on many individual factors, including the Student's degree of involvement and adherence to recommendations. At the same time, the Provider indirectly bears responsibility for the process of providing services and undertakes to work with each Student in good faith, using previously repeatedly successfully tested methods and solutions. 6. CONFIDENTIALITY

6.1. The Parties undertake not to disclose confidential information obtained from each other during the performance of this Agreement, except as provided by the legislation of the Russian Federation.

6.2. The Provider undertakes not to disclose personal information and details of the Student's problems obtained during the sessions without his/her direct consent.

7. MISCELLANEOUS

7.1. All disputes and disagreements arising from this Agreement shall be resolved through negotiations. If it is impossible to resolve a dispute through negotiations, it shall be considered in court at the Provider's location.

7.2. This Agreement is made in two copies, having equal legal force, one for each Party.

7.3. In all other respects not provided for by this Agreement, the Parties shall be governed by the current legislation of the Russian Federation.
